REGULAR VERBS

Spelling rules

Infinitive + ed/d	visit – visited love – loved
Vowel + y: ed	enjoy – enjoyed
Consonant + y: ied	study – studied
One-syllable verb 1 vowel + 1 consonant: Double consonant + ed	stop – stopped bat – batted
Two-syllable with stress on second syllable and ending with a single consonant: Double consonant + ed	permit – permitted commit – committed
